Primary Function

Evaluate the organization's current or proposed activities, operations, equipment, laboratories, facilities, and processes to minimize their impact on the environment. Conduct environmental tests; analyze and evaluate results. Recommend corrective action to ensure the organization complies with environmental regulations.

Responsibilities

Plant:

- Perform analysis of manufacturing methods to achieve cost reductions or process improvements.
- Lead 5S or 6 sigma process teams.
- Lead plant C.I. teams.
- Make recommendations regarding factory equipment needs.
- Maintain all plant equipment calibrations.
- Maintain the plant ISO procedures.
 - Perform ISO internal audits.
- Maintain the plant ASME procedures.

EH&S:

- Establish strategic priorities and develop, implement, and monitor safety and occupational health initiatives.
- Represent the plant on the EH&S council. Report plant issues / needs to the council. Report council initiatives to the plant.
- Lead the plant EH&S team.
- Provide safety/OSHA required training to the plant and conduct safety audits.
- Work with regulatory agencies and outside auditors to achieve plant EH&S goals and compliance.
- Manage hazardous waste profiles and transport manifests.
- Perform incident (injury) investigations and manage the claim process.
- Oversee the collection, treatment, storage, transportation, and shipping of hazardous waste for safe and legal handling.
- Investigate spills, releases, emissions, or other incidents; complete or verify incident reports; and liaise with other specialists and environmental agencies to identify causes of these incidents and prevent recurrence.
- Maintain and analyze environmental records.
- Prepare and submit environmental reports.
- Develop project plans to rehabilitate damaged or contaminated sites.
- Keep abreast of environmental regulations so the organization's environmental management policies remain current and relevant.
- Educate and train the workforce on emergency response procedures, handling hazardous materials, and other aspects of environmental management to ensure they comply with the organization's environmental policies.
